Voters are registered under one party, and wish to change but do not take the time.

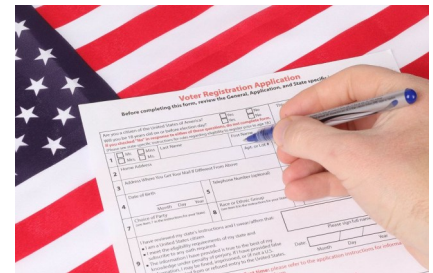
Women change their names,

eral Election ballot.

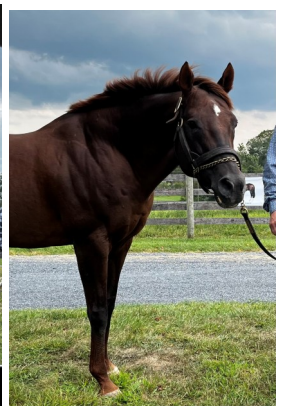
